

Small Doll

A small doll that can be decorated in any way you like!

by Country Town Crochet

Materials

Yarn of choice (Skin Tone, I use DK weight)

Yarn of choice (Pants, I use DK weight)

3.5mm hook (Adjust hook size depending preference and yarn size.)

Stitch markers

Darning needle

Stuffing

Safety eyes (I used 10mm, these are optional as you can embroider instead)

Scissors

Abbreviations (US terminology)

mr - magic ring

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

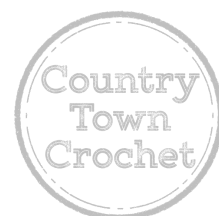
inc - increase

dec - decrease (Invisible decrease unless otherwise stated)

blo - back loop only

sl - slip stitch

fo - fasten off



Arms (make 2)

Starting in desired skin tone

R1:	6 sc into a mr	= 6
R2:	2 (2 sc, 1 inc)	= 8
R3-10:	sc around	= 8

FO both arms and set aside.

Legs (make 2)

Starting in desired pants colour

R1:	6 sc into a mr	= 6
R2:	2 (2 sc, 1 inc)	= 8
R3:	2 (3 sc, 1 inc)	= 10
R4-13:	sc around	= 10

FO the first leg and set it aside. We will be continuing on to the body from the second leg.

Head and Body

Continuing from where we left off on the second leg

R14:	ch 2, 10 sc into the first leg, 2 sc into the back of the chain, 10 sc into the second leg, 2 sc into the front of the chain	= 24
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Stuff the legs.

R15-21:	sc around	= 24
R22:	change skin tone, blo sc around	= 24
R23-25:	sc around	= 24

At this point we will bring the arms in.

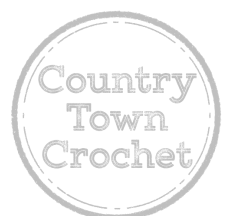
R26:	sc until you reach the side of the body, 8 sc into the first arm, sc until you reach the second side of the body, 8 sc into the second arm, sc until you reach end of row	= 40
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Stuff the arms.

R27:	8 (3 sc, 1 dec)	= 32
R28:	8 (2 sc, 1 dec)	= 24

Stuff the body.

R29:	dec around	= 12
R30-31:	sc around	= 12
R32:	6 (1 sc, 1 inc)	= 18
R33:	1 sc, 1 inc, 5 (2 sc, 1 inc), 1 sc	= 24
R34:	6 (3 sc, 1 inc)	= 30



R35:	2 sc, 1 inc, 5 (4 sc, 1 inc), 2 sc	= 36
R36:	6 (5 sc, 1 inc)	= 42
R37:	3 sc, 1 inc, 5 (6 sc, 1 inc), 3 sc	= 48
R38-45:	sc around	= 48
R46:	3 sc, 1 dec, 5 (6 sc, 1 dec), 3 sc	= 42
R47:	6 (5 sc, 1 dec)	= 36
R48:	2 sc, 1 dec, 5 (4 sc, 1 dec), 2 sc	= 30

Stop here and attach the safety eyes. I attach mine about half way down the head with about 6 stitches in between.

Begin stuffing the head.

R49:	6 (3 sc, dec)	= 24
R50:	1 sc, 1 dec, 5 (2 sc, 1 dec), 1 sc	= 18
R51:	6 (1 sc, 1 dec)	= 12

Finish stuffing the head.

R52:	dec around	= 6
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FO and use the tail to weave through the tops of the remaining 6 stitches, pull tight to close the hole in the top of the head. Your doll body is now done!

From here you can make any sort of outfit and hair to customize the doll to your liking.
